











# How to correctly dispose of your packaging

The correct disposal of packaging in separate collection is fundamental for optimization of the recycling processes. Grundfos products use the following packaging materials which should be correctly disposed of in separate

collection, sorted and recycled according to the provisions of your local authority. The symbols included on the packaging material will help you to identify the material category to perform the correct separation.

	Polypropylene	PP	Bags, Buckets, Cradle, Foil cover blanket, Straps, Tapes	Plastic
	Polystyrene	PS	Inserts, Linings, Straps	Plastic
	Other plastics (e.g. polyester, polyamide PA, polylactic acid PLA)	OTHER	Bands, Straps, Tapes	Plastic
	Corrugated cardboard	PAP	Boxes, Inserts, Sleeves, Lids, Separators, Trays	Paper
	Non-corrugated cardboard	PAP	Honeycombs, Paper board, Moulded paper	Paper
	Paper	PAP	Paper sheets	Paper
	Wood	FOR	Boxes, Pallets, Cradles, Crates, Supports, Planks, Plywood plate	Wood
